❑ Q: So what is this service?

This service allows you to copy files from one location on the file system to another file on the file system.

❑ Q: How does it work?

This Service takes six service runtime parameters

1. Create Directory if doesn't exist -- This parameter if set to true will create the file directory for the destination file if it does not exist already. If set to false the service will fail.
2. Destination Directory – Directory where the file will be copied to.
3. Destination Filename – Filename of the new file
4. Remove Source File – Delete the original file if the copy is successful.
5. Replace existing File – if file already exists replace it with this file
6. Source File – Original file to be copied to another location

▼ Runtime Parameters
